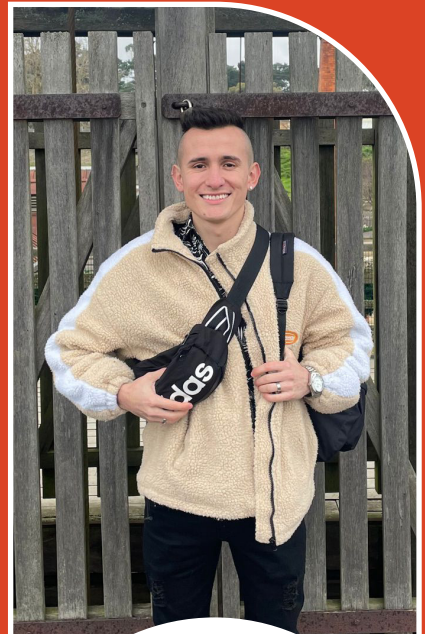

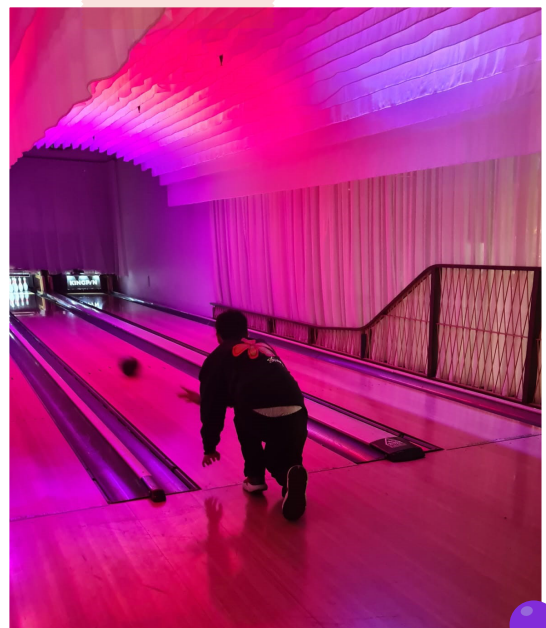
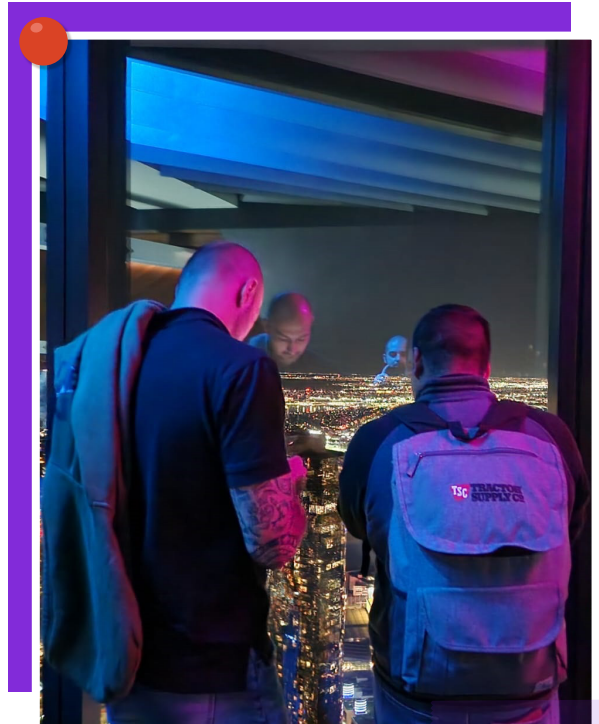
Conditions:

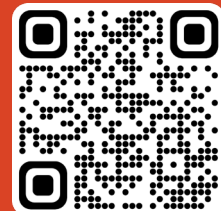
